

2009/2010 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Sub-grant Awards

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) signed into law by President Obama on February 17, 2009, the **Fulton County Arts Council applied for and was awarded \$250,000 through the National Endowment for the Arts to sub-grant to nonprofit arts organizations for projects that met the intent of the program: the preservation of jobs in the arts.**
